





#### Naming Files & Folders

- ◆ names should make sense
- ◆ names that are descriptive.
- ◆ imagine that a total stranger has to use your file structure – will they understand words?



#### File Structure

##### *Why is this important?*

- ◆ File structure is basis of good architecture
- ◆ Web pages are instructions for Browser (IE, Firefox, Opera, Safari, etc.)



#### File Structure

##### *Why is this important?*

- ◆ HTML files are instructions or recipes
- ◆ Some ingredients are stored in other files



#### File Structure

- ◆ images are loaded into a page
- ◆ html code:

- ◆ This means:
  - Show an image, and here's how you find it:
  - Look on a web server called: mit220.ca
  - Look into a folder called: images
  - Show a file called "logo.gif"



#### File Structure

- ◆ many other things are loaded into a page in a similar way
- ◆ pages link to one another too
- ◆ html code:  
`<a href="http://mit220.ca/exercises/critiques.htm">  
Here are the critiques</a>`
- ◆ This means:
  - This is a link, and here's the file you are going to take us to:
  - Look on a web server called: mit220.ca
  - Look into a folder called: exercises
  - Show a file called "critiques.htm"



#### Hints for good file structure

- ◆ If you don't have a folder for your work, create that first
- ◆ The first time you save something, try using the 'save as' function
- ◆ Remember where you want to put this file
- ◆ Don't just click save or use the save shortcut until you've already saved it to the right folder
